

SNJ STUDIO COVID-19 PROCEDURES

(February 2022)

- **Wellness** - In the case that you are experiencing, or have experienced within the last 7 days, a cough, fever, shortness of breath, difficulties breathing, fatigue, flu-like symptoms, gastrointestinal upset or a loss of taste or smell, please do not come to the studio. Instead, please contact your teacher to take that week's lesson remotely. Faculty members are asked to do the same. Faculty and students may return to the studio after 7 days or after receiving a negative Covid-19 test result.
- **Exposure** - If a student or faculty member has been directly exposed to a person who has tested positive for Covid-19, do not come to the studio for either a period of 7 days from the time of exposure or after receiving a negative Covid-19 test result. Lessons during that period will be conducted remotely.
- **Masks** – The use of masks in the common areas of the studios is now at the discretion of the individual. Inside the private teaching rooms masks are also optional, but with two important caveats:
 - If an individual student or parent would like masks to be worn in the teaching room, our faculty will gladly comply.
 - Some of our teachers have ongoing health conditions that make them more vulnerable. These teachers may ask that masks continue to be worn in their private teaching rooms for the time being. We ask our students and parents to comply.

With these procedures in place, it is our goal to keep our students and faculty safe while continuing to make music together.
